Makerspace to foster creativity and entrepreneurship utilizing technology ranging from a sewing machine to a 3D printer

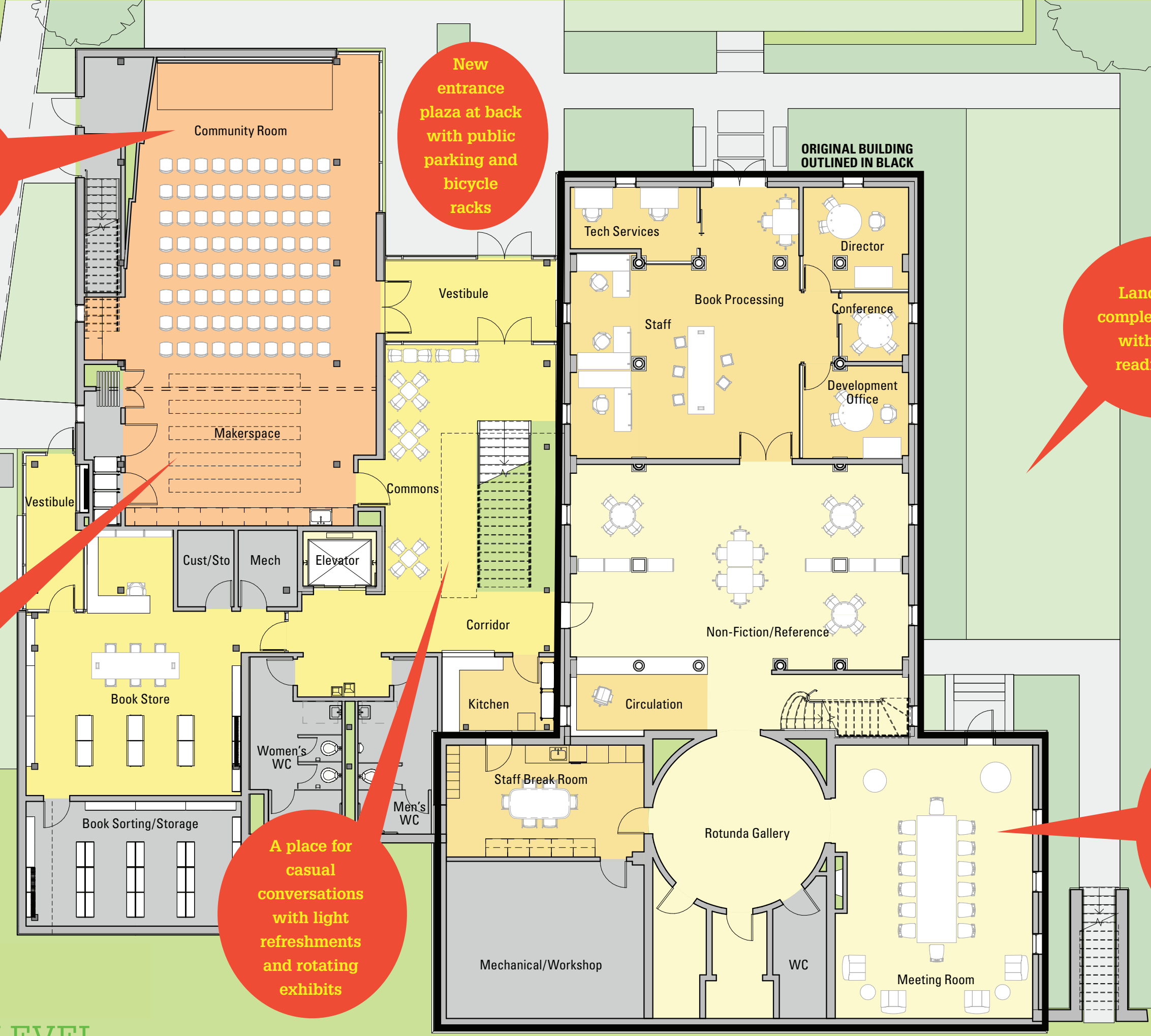
New entrance plaza at back with public parking and bicycle racks

Noisy/quiet rooms are sound-insulated for phone calls, tutoring, or small meetings

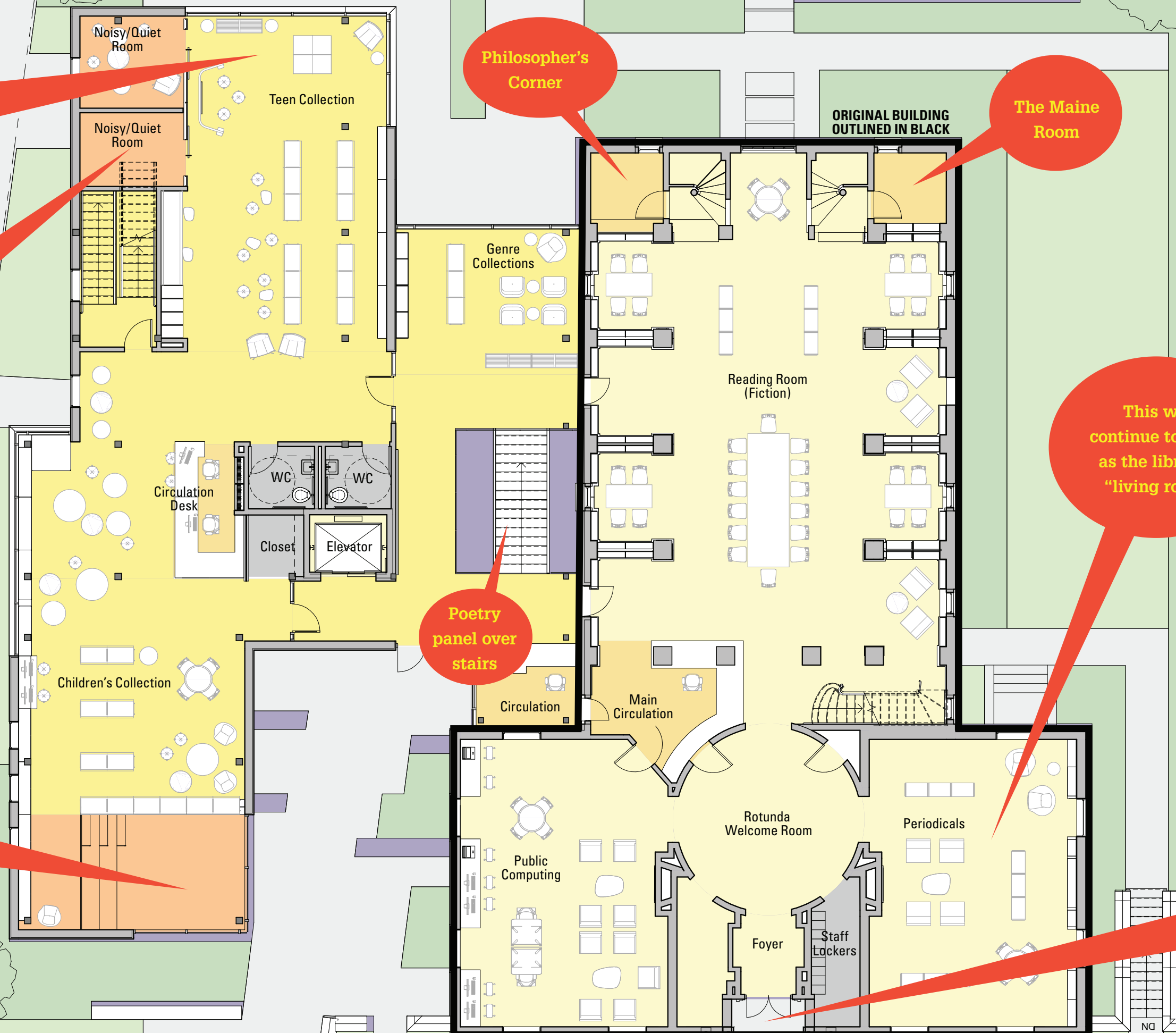
